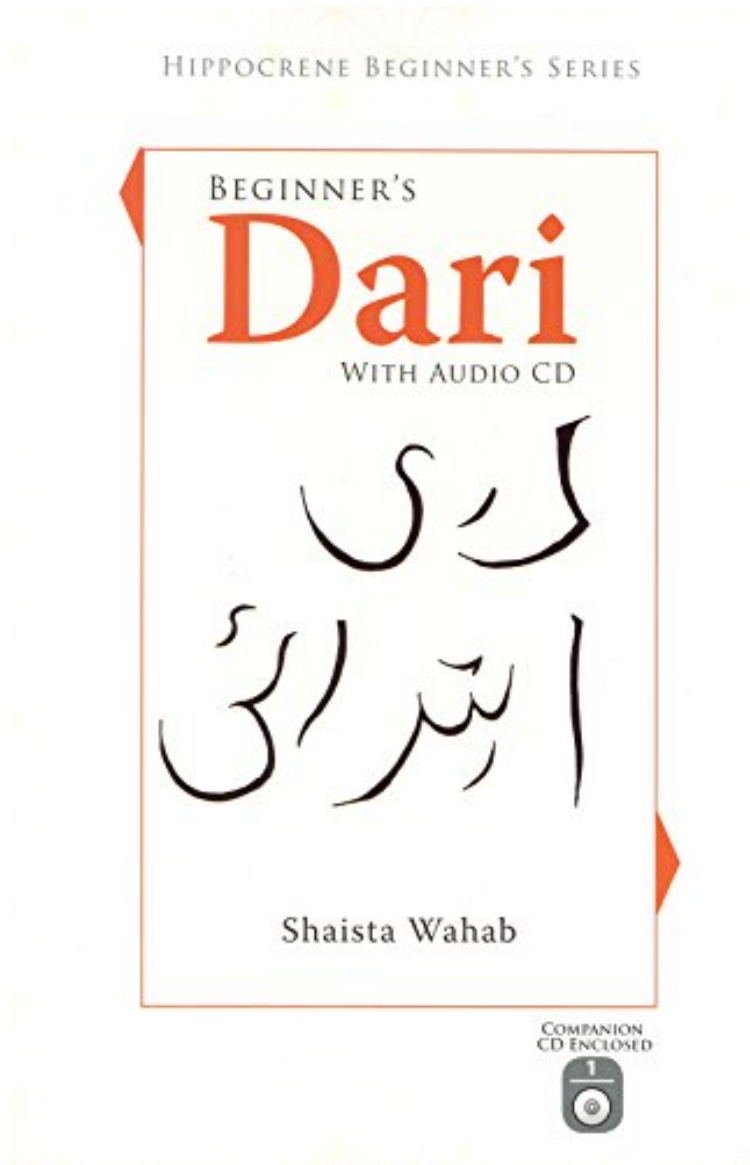

The student who wants to take their Farsi to the next level will have to find another source but for \$13 this is a steal. You will get a lot out of this book. Also, the language itself is very easy. I suggest bypassing the script and learn the vocabulary and grammar with the aid of the audio first before learning to read Dari. Don't worry, there are transliterations in the book. It begins with the alphabet and lessons to begin memorizing the 32 letters and progresses to grammar and sentence structure.
