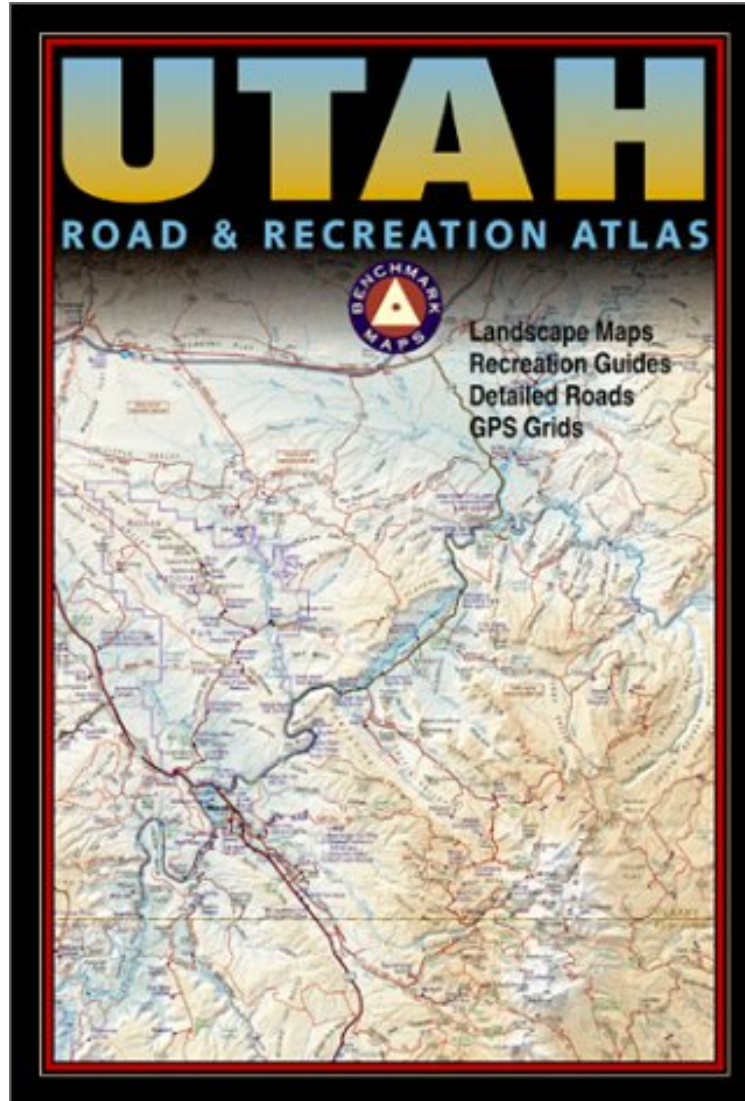

Benchmarks are better because they overlap a bit from page to page, making navigation easier; they have national, regional and the whole State map at the front. They also have 'recreation' in order to look for specific activity - say campgrounds. Some States have separate pages
